### **Awareness Campaign regarding promotion of ragging-free environment among the students of Undergraduate Semester –I of Krishnagar Government College.**





**Objective:** To create a ragging-free and peaceful environment on campus, and to raise awareness among students about the college's grievance redressal system and the higher education system concerning the prevention of ragging.

**Target Audience:** Undergraduate students in their first semester across these departments at Krishnagar Government College.

**Description of the event:** Members of the Anti-Ragging Committees and the Anti-Ragging squad of the college (Dr. Dipanwita Majumder, Dr. Tanima Chatterjee, Dr. Mrinal Kanti Basak, Dr. Moumita Dey) visited three departments (Botany, Zoology, Physiology) and the College Canteen. ### **The process of registering complaints follows this thread**

Contact and inform the faculty of the department about the event- Inform the Head of the department- Inform the members of the Anti-Ragging Squad and Anti-Ragging Committee via the Head of the Department- Inform the Head of the Institution via the concerned Committee. If the case is not resolved, they can write to the email ID provided on the College website or contact the concerned person using the phone number provided on the College website.

Students are encouraged to foster a friendly campus environment and practice good behavior with their peers as well as teaching and non-teaching staff.

**Outcome:** Students get the detailed information about the ragging-related rules, regulations, and penalties, and actively participate in the interactive session.


