

Submission of a manuscript implies: that the work described has not been published before; that it is not under consideration for publication anywhere else; that its publication has been approved by all co-authors, if any, as well as by the responsible authorities –tacitly or explicitly –at the institute where the work has been carried out. The publisher will not be held legally responsible should there be any claims for compensation.

Permissions

Authors wishing to include figures, tables, or text passages that have already been published elsewhere are required to obtain permission from the copyright owner (s) for both the print and online format and to include evidence that such permission has been granted when submitting their papers. Any material received without such evidence will be assumed to originate from the authors.

Title Page

The title page should include:

- A brief title.
- The name(s) of the author(s)

- The affiliation(s) and address(es) of the author(s).
- The e-mail address, and telephone number(s) of the corresponding author.
- If available, the 16-digit ORCID of the author(s)

Abstract

Please provide an abstract of not more than 250 words. The abstract should not contain any undefined abbreviations or unspecified references.

Keywords

Please provide 3 to 6 keywords which can be used for indexing purposes.

Text Formatting

- Manuscripts should be written in MS-Word.
- Use a normal, plain font (e.g., 11 -point Times Roman with 1.5 pt spacing) for text.
- Use italics for emphasis.
- Use the automatic page numbering function to number the pages.
- Do not use field functions.
- Use tab stops or other commands for indents, not the space bar.
- Use the table function, not spreadsheets, to make tables.
- Use the equation editor or Math Type for equations.
- save your file in docx format (Word 2007 or higher) or doc format (older Word versions).
- Submit the pdf version of the manuscript initially for review purpose. The editable file (word) will be required after the manuscript has been accepted for publication.**

Scientific style

- Please always use internationally accepted signs and symbols for units (SI units).
- Nomenclature: Insofar as possible, authors should use systematic names similar to those used by Chemical Abstract Service or IUPAC.

Headings

Please use no more than three levels of displayed headings.

Abbreviations

Abbreviations should be defined at first mention and used consistently thereafter.

Footnotes

If not avoidable, always use footnotes instead of endnotes.

Acknowledgments

Acknowledgments of people, grants, funds, etc. should be placed in a separate section on the title page. The names of funding organizations should be written in full.

Reference list

The list of references should only include works that are cited in the text and that have been published or accepted for publication. Personal communications and unpublished works should only be mentioned in the text. Do not use footnotes or endnotes as a substitute for a reference list.

Reference list entries should be alphabetized by the last names of the first author of each work. Order multi-author publications of the same first author alphabetically with respect to second, third, etc. author. Publications of exactly the same author(s) must be ordered chronologically.

References should be numbered using Arabic numerals followed by a period (.) as shown below and should follow the format in the below examples.
